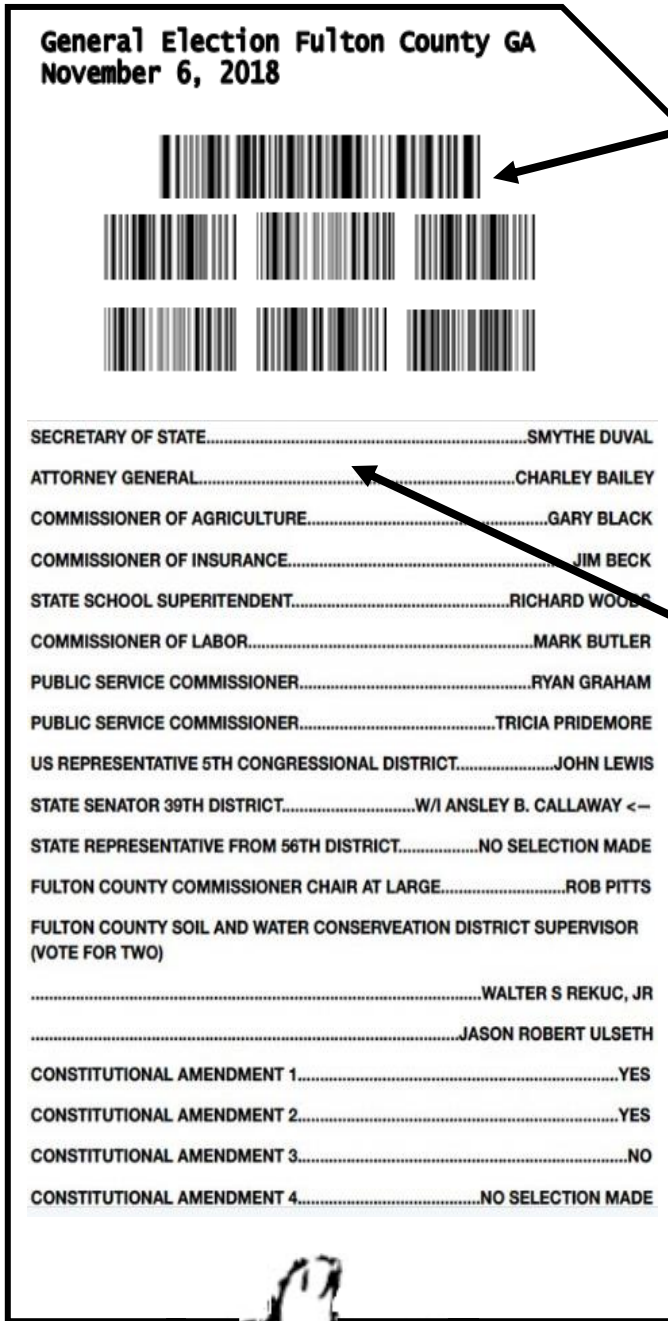


This is what a “scanning ballot” might look like:



?? Voter Verification ??

Notice the series of barcodes that allegedly encode the selections of the voter. Why are they there?

How do you know that these barcodes accurately reflect whom you voted for?

The barcodes, not the human-readable portion, are scanned and tabulated in the optical scan machines.

This is not the same ballot format you saw while casting your vote. How easy is it to make sense of this summary?

Can you memorize a long ballot? Could you remember if any race is omitted?

What exactly did Constitutional Amendment 1 say? “Do I really mean to vote YES on that measure?” you might ask yourself.

Research has shown that a very small percentage of voters take sufficient time to confirm that these summaries reflect their choices.



Tell your legislators to vote NO on any election system that does not record, tabulate and audit human-readable marks.
