

CALL FOR FORENSIC INVESTIGATIONS INTO GEORGIA ELECTION FRAUD

Lt. Gov. Duncan, Speaker Ralston, Chairman Strickland, Chairwoman Taylor,

During the month of December, the Senate Judiciary Sub Committee and House Government Affairs Committee, chaired by Sen. Ligon and Rep. Blackmon respectively, collected an overwhelming array of convincing facts & evidence indicating wrongdoing in the conduct of the November 3rd election. Active lawsuits filed in Georgia have provided even more evidence concerning both the November 3rd and January 5th elections. For example:

1. At least four sworn affidavits from 20-year poll managers indicate they handled counterfeit ballots in the November 14th and 15th Fulton County hand count audit. The potential numbers of these ballots scale to the tens of thousands based on the samples they personally witnessed;
2. There is concrete visual evidence from the State Farm Arena videos of illegal scanning, rescanning and hiding of ballots processed during the November 3rd election;
3. There are massive, inexplicable vote spikes in Fulton, DeKalb and other counties from the mail-in ballot processing for both the November 3rd and January 5th elections;
4. The Dominion voting systems inexplicably failed to tabulate or operate correctly in several counties during both the November 3rd and January 5th elections;
5. There is evidence that the Dominion system flipped votes from Donald Trump to Joe Biden in the November 3rd election.

We are now hearing that the legislature is taking several steps they believe will correct the problems encountered in these two recent elections. Ironically, those in charge are many of the same members who were behind the 2019 passage of HB316 which legalized a new wave of unverifiable bar code voting over our continual objections and contained other provisions that resulted in catastrophic consequences we experienced in 2020.

It is simply **not credible** for these same members to claim they will fix the problems they created without ever investigating the most serious problems described above. Therefore, we call upon the legislature to pass a joint resolution to **instruct counties to allow independent forensic exams of the physical ballots and Dominion voting systems** in counties where problems were experienced. We also call on each legislator to join us in signing a [letter](#) that they be included as [petitioners](#) for a grand jury investigation. To achieve credibility, the General Assembly must sincerely attempt to get to the bottom of what happened in the 2020 Georgia elections.
